## Ancient Tamil Words in the Tribal Languages of South India

**Announcement and Invitation** 

This Workshop to be conducted from 19.06.2024 to 28.06.2024 will focus its attention on the tribal languages of India which has been a subject of close study by learned men for more than a century. They have brought to light a number of historical truths about the habits, festivals, arts, medicine, beliefs, rituals, ceremonies and dialects of the tribal's of South India. Astonishing similarities have been discovered among the various tribal cultures. But because of the incredible developments in science and technology, there has been a lot of transformation in the life-style of these tribal populations. As a result of this, some of the traditional values of their life and their dialects are facing endangerment.

Celebrated Indian and Western linguists are of the view that Tamil has been the main source of all these tribal languages including *Brahui* and a few more in the northern parts of India. They have been able to identify almost all the South Indian tribal languages such as *peṭṭakurumpā*, *mullukurumpā*, *kāṇikkārana*, *kāṭṭunāyakkā*, *kacapā*, *kāṭar*, *paṇiyā*, *cōlikā*, *ūrāli*, *pālukurumpā*, *eravallā*, *korakā*, *irulā*, *kūyi*, *aṭiyā* and *narikkuravā*. In these languages, a large number of ancient Tamil words relating to politics, religion, philosophy, music, dance, painting, sculpture, architecture, games, food, dress, entertainment, rituals and ceremonies are to be found.

This refresher Course will attempt to throw light on these words. Specialists in this field will give lectures on this aspect of the tribal languages.

Those doing research in all the related areas are welcome to attend the course.
