The details of the posts, educational qualification, age, experience and application format are given below. The candidates are requested to submit their applications complete in all respects before 19.05.2025 along with requisite application fee and all necessary documents. Applications received after the last date for receipt for applications will not be entertained.

1.	Candidates are required to apply offline through the application attached with the advertisement. Candidates are advised to read the detailed advertisement carefully before filling up the application.
2.	Applications received after the last date shall summarily be rejected without any reason whatsoever and the institute will not be held responsible for any kind of delay. Applications received through emails followed by original applications before the last date for receipt of applications only will be considered. If applications are sent only through emails they will not be considered.
3.	The qualifications and other conditions prescribed in the advertisement are as per UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education 2018 (herein after referred as UGC Regulations 2018) published in the Gazette of India, July 18, 2018 and UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Amendment regulations 2021 (and NCTE norms wherever applicable) and are subject to future regulations/norms, including amendments in UGC regulations from time to time , stipulated by the MHRD/UGC applicable to such recruitments. 4.	A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 th September, 1991. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.

5.	Candidates serving in private institutions are not eligible for pay protection of their past service or counting of past service for any purpose in the new post, in case of their selection and joining.
6.	Candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose " <u>Equivalence Certificate</u> " issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will summarily be rejected
7.	For the post of Professor, the academic / research score shall be calculated as specified in Annexure C .
8. 3.	The prescribed qualification and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. Director's decision will be final on determining the minimum number of applications required for screening and minimum number of candidates for Interview.
4.	The Institute reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed as decided by the duly constituted Screening Committee and approved by the Competent Authority based on prescribed norms of the Institute. The Screening committee shall screen the application as per UGC norms. Call letters for attending interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates by Speed Post or Registered Post or Courier and also by email. The number of candidates to be called for interview will be as per the decision of the Institute.
5.	The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing research degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment.
6.	Reservations for SC, ST, OBC, EWS candidates and Persons with Disabilities exist as per guidelines of the UGC/GOI. Methodology of Shortlisting the Candidates

1. The applications so received shall be placed before a Screening Committee, which on the basis of criteria so decided, shall prepare a list of all the eligible candidates indicating the marks scored by them in descending order i.e. starting from the candidate getting the highest marks towards the candidates getting the lower marks.
2. Based on their score as per criteria given above, **a maximum of up to 15 candidates will be called for interview against each post of Professor.** In case of any dispute with regard to screening of the applications, the decision of the Screening Committee shall be final.

- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
